Redemptive storytelling

Before studying in the Digital Storytelling program, Han was an investigative journalist, working for top media companies in Beijing and Hong Kong and winning many prizes. She considered pursuing a PhD in anthropology, but found the MA in Digital Storytelling program better suited to her interests.

Program structure

Cohort learning

Throughout the duration of the program, students will study together with the same group (the cohort), going through the same courses together in the same sequence. This has the benefit of building a strong sense of community within the learning cohort.

Hybrid learning

Our model of hybrid learning combines face-to-face instruction with online learning, offering greater flexibility on your time.

In-person learning allows for hands-on experience with a range of equipment and lively discussions with peers and faculty, while online courses involve learning through a multimedia platform, peer reviews of projects, and more.



Course highlight

Cross-Platform Storytelling

Students will learn the theoretical foundations of designing nonlinear and interactive narratives across a variety of communication technology contexts, including social media, virtual worlds and video games. This course will be writing-intensive, with projects focused on creating effective narratives for multiple digital platforms. Upon completion of this course, students will possess the theoretical and practical knowledge to produce quality stories in a diversified media landscape.
